Objective:

The course syllabus covers the competencies as required in element/s related to Free Fall Lifeboat in STCW 1995 Section A – VI / 2 Table A – VI / 2-1 and section 5.4 of the IMO Model Course 1.23.

Trainees who successfully complete this course shall be able to undertake tasks, duties and responsibilities related to launch and recovery of a Free Fall Lifeboat and take charge of a boat as a Coxswain and for other related duties as Designated Persons.
