



BTOCT (Basic Training for Oil and Chemical Tanker)

(DG APPROVED)

Duration: 6 DAYS

Conducted at: Mumbai

Objective:

This basic familiarization course is for officer and rating assigned specific duties and responsibilities related to cargo and cargo equipment on oil and chemical tankers.

The course is approved by the Directorate General of Shipping and meets the training requirements laid down in Regulation V/1-1 paragraph 2, Section A-V/I-1 paragraph 1 and Table A-V /1-1-1 of the STCW Convention and Code as amended in 2010, related to Oil and Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations.

Subject Areas:

1. Basic Knowledge of tanker
2. Hazards
3. Safety
4. Proper use of Safety equipment and protective devices.
5. Basic Knowledge of safe working practices
6. Fire safety and Firefighting Operations
7. Cargo Operations for oil and chemical tanker
8. Emergencies for Oil and Chemical tankers
9. Pollution Prevention for Oil and Chemical Tankers
10. Case studies on Oil and NLS ship emergencies

USP:

1. This course combines the existing IMO/DGS requirements of OILFAM and CHEMFAM into one.
2. Concept building about all types of tankers
3. The course covers all the safety aspects for a joining crew.

Eligibility:

Deck and engine officer/ crew who are joining oil/chemical tankers for the 1st time.
